- Rabbit control;
- Sealing of Clarke Street outside post office and
- Public Wi-Fi at community hall.

### *We will promote*

COUNCIL WILL PROMOTE THE NEED FOR DAY CARE OPPORTUNITIES; AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES AND PICK UP OF CHILDREN; AND EXERCISE CLASSES OPERATING FROM COMMUNITY HALL.

### *We will advocate*

COUNCIL WILL ADVOCATE TO VICROADS REGARDING HIGHWAY POISONING, WE WILL ALSO EMPHASISE THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFETY AT THE RING ROAD AND HENTY HIGHWAY INTERSECTION AND DISCUSS MANAGEMENT OF ROAD VERGES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.

### *We will investigate*

COUNCIL WILL INVESTIGATE THE INTEGRITY OF THE BUILDING ALONG THE PATH AT THE END OF EAST STREET; THE POT HOLES AT THE DROP OFF POINT AT THE NARRAWONG PRIMARY SCHOOL; CLEARING OF DRAIN FROM SURREY RIVER; AND POTENTIAL FOR KERBSIDE WASTE COLLECTION IN NARRAWONG.
