- 3. **Dwelling floor plan**, clearly identify all rooms and plumbing exit points.
- 4. **Proof of ownership** Copy of title and title plan and/or Contract of Sale.
- 5. Payment of relevant fees.

- 2. This application form is a legal document and penalties exist for providing false or misleading information.
- 3. If the Applicant is not the Owner I/We the applicant, hereby declare that we have notified the owner about this application and consent to a copy of the permit being forwarded to the owner.
- 4. The owner is aware of the requirements of this septic tank system and the associated maintenance required for the life of the system.
- 5. That my system once installed cannot be used until an inspection of the system has been carried out and an Approval to Use Certificate has been issued.
- 6. I understand that it is an offence under the Environment Protection Act 2017 for my system to be used without an Approval to use Certificate having been issued and that a fine maybe imposed by Council.
