#### TIMBER TOWNS VICTORIA: STRATEGIC PLAN FOR 2019 - 2022



#### **MISSION**

Timber Towns Victoria (TTV) is the local government voice on the impact of timber related issues on local communities and local government infrastructure.

#### **KEY OBJECTIVES**

- To provide leadership and advocacy for the interests of local government on the impact of timber related issues on local government and their communities, particularly roads infrastructure
- To provide a forum for local government to share information and to address timber related issues
- To be a credible and respected stakeholder on timber issues, representing local government in working with the community, all levels of governments and the timber industry
- To support and assist councils managing the impact of timber related issues
- To support sustainable communities and local government infrastructure.

#### **KEY STRATEGIES**

### **Government Relations:**

- 1. Establish and maintain constructive relationships with the Victorian Government
- 2. Establish and maintain regular contacts with relevant ministers, shadow ministers and staff
- 3. Maintain a close working relationship with relevant government departments and agencies

# **Transport and Infrastructure:**

- 4. Seek funding commitments from the Victorian Government to maintain and upgrade local roads and bridges
- 5. Facilitate information and advice to members on freight, road science and other transport related knowledge sectors, for sustainable road management and capital works planning
- 6. Work with Regional Development Victoria (RDV) and VicRoads on the need for local data to assist with their budget modelling.
- 7. Review outcomes achieved from Timber Industry Road Evaluation Study (TIRES)
- 8. Review outcomes achieved from TTV investment in the Green Triangle Freight Action Plan review.

# **Land Use Management:**

- 1. Monitor timber related statutory obligations and government policies related to forestry on public and private land
- 2. Provide information and advice to members on planning requirements for plantation development and sustainable land use practices
- 3. Promote and encourage councils in the sharing of skills and knowledge on the implementation of the *Code of Practice* for Forestry on Private Land



4. Provide timely and well-informed input into the development of government policies related to the forestry industry

# **TTV Development:**

- 1. Seek increased media opportunities to raise the profile of TTV
- 2. Maintain TTV representation on appropriate external committees and groups

# **The Planning Scheme**

- 1. Work with member councils, where required to assist in the adaptation of a planning schemes that reflects their desired relationship with the forestry industry.
- 2. Assist in the adoption of a Municipal Strategic Statement that identifies the importance of forestry to the local economy.

# **TTV Membership and Services:**

- 1. Deliver forums and other events for all Victorian councils to increase their knowledge and understanding of freight, transport, infrastructure and the impact of the forestry sector
- 2. Encourage TTV members to remain active participants, and provide opportunities for them for relevant and timely information and to engage with state government and industry.
- 3. Encourage non-member councils to join TTV where the forest and wood products industry influences and impacts are significant to local government infrastructure, their community and local economy.
- 4. Develop a satisfaction survey for members
