Portland is one of the premier destinations for whale, seal and gannet sight seeing. With dramatic coastline and volcanic cliffs, isolated beaches, majestic forests, historic buildings and an industrial port blending seamlessly into the town landscape, the area is unsurpassed in options for either leisure or outdoor pursuits.

SHORT WALKS

CAPE NELSON

THE ENCHANTED FOREST

(45 mins – moderate walk – some steps)

A tranquil forest of Moonah (*Melaleuca lanceolata*) makes this 45 minute walk enchanting! On the eastern side of Cape Nelson, it's a wonderful sheltered walk through canopies to lookouts and boardwalks with wonderful viewing platforms and plenty of 'contemplation' nooks.

SEA CLIFF NATURE WALK

(3km – 1 hour gentle loop walk using first path from carpark)

Signposted from the car park at Cape Nelson Rd & Scenic Drive Rd junction (before getting to Lighthouse car park). This walk takes you through coastal scrub, cliff tops and views across spectacular Bridgewater Bay and adjacent farmland.

YELLOW ROCK

(10 minute return walk from the car park)

Yellow Rock is a popular surfing spot and painting subject for local artists. Boardwalks and platforms make this area accessible for prams and wheelchairs, with a staircase leading to the beach.

CAPE BRIDGEWATER

THE BLOWHOLES & PETRIFIED FOREST

(100m from the car park)

Formed mainly of basalt (black) and scoria (purple) rock, the blowholes create spectacular spouts of sea spray during high seas, easily viewable from a platform. In Summer watch for the Blue Whale blow from the same platform. Make sure you walk "through" the Petrified Forest, only a short walk around the cliff top.

TARRAGAL LIMESTONE CAVE

(5 minute walk)

Situated opposite the entrance to Bridgewater Lakes, a steep 50m climb to the caves provides an excellent view across the giant sand dunes of Discovery Bay looking towards Nelson.



SCENIC DRIVES

EXPLORE OUR CAPES

CAPE BRIDGEWATER & DISCOVERY BAY

45 km (1hr 15min driving without stopping).

Sandy beaches, Petrified Forest & Blowholes. Take a 2 hour, energetic return walk to the seal colony. Visit Shelly Beach, Bridgewater Lakes, Tarragal Limestone Cave and view the giant sand dunes of Discovery Bay. Scenic boat trips take you right into the seals cave. Watch out for whales and other sea life.

GANNET DRIVE, POINT DANGER

6 kms (15 mins return)

Bird watchers flock to Point Danger to view Australia's only mainland colony of Australasian Gannets, located 6km from Portland. The colony can be accessed off Madeira Packet Road, near Portland Aluminium (see map above). More than 6,000 pairs of these birds nest at Point Danger and at Lawrence Rocks, 2km south of the mainland.

LIGHTHOUSE LOOP, CAPE NELSON

26 km (45mins driving without stopping)

At the tip of Cape Nelson is a 32m lighthouse built in 1884 of local stone, (tours daily), and view the Lighthouse Keepers Cottages. Short walks on the cape include the Sea Cliff Nature Walk and the Enchanted Forest or view local surfers at Yellow Rock.
