Additionally, there is an option on the form to enter your Clubs membership data and supporting information that will be required as evidence to participate in the *Licence/Lease Fee Incentivisation program*. This program is for current Clubs / User Groups that hold a current Crown Land Licence/Lease with Council. The Incentivisation program offers opportunities for licence/lease fees to be reduced for the next financial year should the Club/User Group be able to meet the key focus areas. More information on this program will be released to Licensed User Groups next financial year (2023-2024).


