DOMESTIC ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS

All dogs and cats three months or older must be registered.

An Excess Animal permit is required to keep more than two dogs and/or two cats within the scheduled areas or a maximum of six domestic animals outside scheduled areas. (See Council's website for maps showing the scheduled areas and an application form).

The registration fee includes a State Levy of \$4.39 per dog and \$4.39 per cat and is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership educational programs.

All animals registered with Council are issued with a lifetime tag for the life of the animal. Replacement tags are available free of charge. Tags remain valid upon payment of the yearly renewal fee due 10 April annually.
