#### **Grants Assistance & Resources**

We are often asked about where Clubs / User Groups can go for assistance with Grants or what funding opportunities are available.

There are some <u>quick links on our website</u> for organisations that regularly release different grant opportunities as well as <u>VicSport</u> offering some helpful links on their website.

Some externally funded grants and fundraising opportunities that may be of particular interest to your club that are currently open include:

- <u>Change Our Game Grants</u> for up to \$10k for community based initiatives that enable participation, build capacity and celebrate the role of women and girls in sport and recreation – applications close 6 March 2023
- Sporting Club Grants Program for up to \$1k for uniforms or equipment, or up to \$2k for skills development programs, or up to \$5k for projects that increase operational capacity – applications close 15 March 2023
- <u>Telstra's Connected Communities Grant Program</u> offers grant up to \$10k for not-for-profit community organisations that are providing access to information, technology, education and facilities to support their communities to embrace new technologies and

ways of working to build social capital and digital capability – applications open 1 March 2023 and close on 30 March 2023

• <u>Australian Sports Foundation</u> provides a platform for tax deductible fundraising
