Additionally, there is an option on the form to enter your Clubs membership data and supporting information that will be required as evidence to participate in the *Licence/Lease Fee Incentivisation program*. This program is for current Clubs / User Groups that hold a current Crown Land Licence/Lease with Council. The Incentivisation program offers opportunities for licence/lease fees to be reduced for the next financial year should the Club/User Group be able to meet the key focus areas. More information on this program will be released to Licensed User Groups by the end of the financial year.

Fair Access Policy Roadmap







## Fair Access Policy Roadmap

The Following an inquiry into Women and Girls in Sport and Active Recreation in 2015, nine recommendations were presented to increase female leadership and participation, with the Victorian Government now committed to increasing the number of women and girls participating in sport and active recreation, from grassroots through to senior leadership roles.

The Change Our Game initiative was launched by the Office for Women in Sport and Recreation (OWSR), to challenge gender stereotypes and help women and girls become leaders.

This has all led to the State Government introducing a Fair Access Policy, which means from July 2024, all Victorian Councils will need to ensure fair access to sporting facilities for people of all genders to be considered eligible to receive infrastructure funding.

In partnership with Sport and Recreation Victoria and VicHealth, the Fair Access Policy Roadmap is being delivered through the Office for Women in Sport and Recreation and aligns with Victoria's Gender Equality Act 2020.

As part of the first phase of the Fair Access Policy Roadmap, Glenelg Shire representatives recently attended a workshop in Warrnambool facilitated by OWSR, to gain an understanding of what is required to be implemented by July 2024. OWSR will also be providing education to sporting peak bodies as part of phase 1 of the roadmap. Some sporting organisations will begin to receive further communications on this policy from their peak bodies over the next year. The Recreation Team will also provide further details on Glenelg Shire's steps to implement the policy requirements in the coming months.
