No Vaping & No Smoking Signage

Council is supporting community groups and facilities to update their smoking and vaping signage, to align with the changes to the *Tabacco Act 1987* which now regulates all e-cigarettes the same way as tobacco products.

Signage at Council-managed facilities will be updated in the coming months, therefore existing Licensed user groups utilising Council managed facilities need not apply.

Grants Assistance & Resources

We are often asked about where Clubs / User Groups can go for assistance with Grants or what funding opportunities are available.

There are some <u>quick links on our website</u> for organisations that regularly release different grant opportunities as well as <u>VicSport</u> offering some helpful links on their website.

Some externally funded grants and fundraising opportunities that may be of particular interest to your club that are currently open include:

- <u>SPORTAUS</u> are offering financial assistance of up to \$750 for coaches, officials and competitors between the ages of 12-18, who are participating in state, national or international championships *applications close 31 July 2023*
- <u>GrainCorp</u> are offering grants of up to \$5,000 for community-related programs/activities or up to \$20,000 for community infrastructure projects that contribute to the development and promotion of the local community under their Community Foundation Grants Program *applications close 31 July 2023*
- Australian Sports Foundation provides a platform for tax deductible fundraising

Additionally, there is an option on the form to enter your Clubs membership data and supporting information that will be required as evidence to participate in the *Licence/Lease Fee Incentivisation program*. This program is for current Clubs / User Groups that hold a current Crown Land Licence/Lease with Council. The Incentivisation program offers opportunities for licence/lease fees to be reduced for the next financial year should the Club/User Group be able to meet the key focus areas. More information on this program will be released to Licensed User Groups within the coming months.
