DAY 1 Friday 14 July 2023

Start with us early in the morning from Seymour or join at Southern Cross as we journey out west on the main line towards Adelaide also picking up enroute at North Shore (Greater Geelong). Settle back and take in the sights of the You Yangs and the western grazing district as we rush towards the junction station of Maroona.

Remain on board whilst our heritage diesel locomotives run around our train to lead us on a leisurely stroll down the freight only branch line towards Portland. Perhaps join friends for a drink in the iconic Parlor car or the open air experience of the Observation car as we roll along at a sedate 40kmh. Refreshments will be available for purchase in our onboard kiosk and a light lunch is included in your fare. We arrive at Portland in the early evening and you will be transferred to your hotel by coach. This evening is at leisure. (L)

DAY 2 Saturday 15 July 2023

You may wish to stay in Portland for the day and enjoy one of our optional day tours including a visit to the World Heritage listed indigenous aquaculture site of Budj Bim. Or perhaps join our optional rail day trip to Hamilton. The choice is yours.

DAY 3

Sunday 16 July 2023

From either our central pick up location or your hotel, transfer by bus back to reboard our train for Melbourne. Relax once more in the Parlor car or the Observation car whilst we make our way back along the branch towards Maroona. Enjoy a boxed dinner this evening as we speed towards North Shore and Southern Cross. A late evening arrival in Seymour is anticipated at the end of our exciting weekend away. - (L,D)


